Winners will be selected in April, and the certificate will be presented in May at the scholarship awards ceremony at the recipient's school. (Scholarship will not be disbursed until proof of enrollment for the Fall 2019 semester is received from the winner's college of attendance.)

All items of this application must be submitted together to your school's guidance office by the deadline listed below. Please take into consideration the following items:

- Emphasis will be placed on community involvement/community service/leadership roles and volunteer activities.
- Letters of recommendation must be SEALED by the individual who wrote the letter when submitted.
- Application Deadline: Friday, April 19, 2019 no late submissions will be accepted.
- Please return all components of the application to your guidance office no mailed or emailed applications will be accepted
- Personal interviews may be conducted.
- Transcripts do not need to be provided.
- One \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded.
